



## Lieutenant Governor of Alberta History Quiz Show Girl Guides Spring 2020 Contest Information & Frequently Asked Questions



**Who can participate?** All levels of Girl Guides are welcome to participate in this special contest. There will be a draw for prizes for each of the 5 categories – Sparks, Brownies, Guides, Pathfinders and Rangers.

**When does the Contest start?** The contest runs from May 4<sup>th</sup> – May 28<sup>th</sup>, 2020.

**How does the contest work?** After the Girl Guide, or their parent, registers for the contest they will play the game by watching 3 episodes of the show per week. The episodes will be found on the Girl Guide Contest link, found at [www.BowValleyRanche.com](http://www.BowValleyRanche.com), starting May 4<sup>th</sup>, 2020.

**How do Girl Guides register?** To register, Girl Guides (or parents) are asked to send an email to the Girl Guide Spring 2020 Contest Coordinator, Dana Wagner (email: [dlwagner@wildroseinternet.ca](mailto:dlwagner@wildroseinternet.ca)). Please include in the subject line of your email - the first name of the Girl Guide, their level and what city or town they are from. At the end of the contest, the participating Guides will submit their completed Score Sheets to Dana Wagner to be entered into the draw.

**How do you play the game?** During each episode, after every question is asked on the show, the question and possible answers will appear on the screen. The Girl Guide (or their parents) can then pause the show while they have an opportunity to answer the question in real time. They will then put down their answer on the score sheet provided. Then, press play to find out if your answer was correct. Each episode will take approximately 30 minutes to play.

### What are the themes of the contest?

Week 1 (May 4<sup>th</sup>) Military Theme – These episodes were filmed at the Bomber Command Museum of Canada in Nanton, AB

Week 2 (May 11<sup>th</sup>) Calgary Stampede & Rural Alberta History Theme – These episodes were filmed at the Historic Bow Valley Ranche in Fish Creek Provincial Park in Calgary.

Week 3 (May 18<sup>th</sup>) Sports Theme – These episodes were filmed at The Alberta Sports Hall of Fame and Museum in Red Deer, AB

Week 4 (May 25<sup>th</sup>) Music Theme – These episodes were filmed at the Studio Bell, Home of the National Music Centre in Calgary.

**Are there prizes?** Yes! Prizes include the Lieutenant Governor of Alberta's official coin, copies of *The History Wrangler's* award winning book and \$25 gift certificates.

**How are the prizes awarded?** They will be awarded by way of a draw. The final draw will be held on Friday May 29<sup>th</sup>. The winners will be announced the next day.

### What is the Gold medal round?

Each theme is comprised of three episodes; Episode 1, Episode 2 and The Gold Medal Round, in which the Lieutenant Governor of Alberta asks the final question herself, either in person or via video.
